- 100 - *Elaeocarpus grandis* - Blue quandong – multi-trunk diameters 23, 19 cms
- 101 - *Guioa semiglauc*a - Wild Quince – multi 17, 19 cms
- 102 - *Waterhousea floribunda* - Weeping lilly pilly – multi 49, 27 cms
- 103 - *Streblus brunonianus* – Whalebone tree – multi 24, 20, 9, 29, 17 cms
- 104 - *Eucalyptus propinqua* - Grey gum – 26 cms
- 105 - *Olea paniculata* - Native olive – 21 cms
- 106 - *Eucalyptus propinqua* - Grey gum – 32 cms
- 107 - *Eucalyptus propinqua* - Grey gum – 32 cms
- 108 - *Elaeocarpus grandis* - Blue quandong – 25 cms
- 109 - *Waterhousea floribunda* - Weeping lilly pilly – multi 37, 27, 17, 28 cms
- 110 - *Elaeocarpus obovatus* – Hard quandong – multi 58, 37 cms
(Ed measured Nicholas Park Hard quandong at 124 cms dbh – so much larger)
- 111 - *Maclura cochinchinensis* – Cockspur thorn vine – 8 cms
- 112 - *Castanospermum australe* – Black bean – 17 cms
- 113 - *Alectryon tomentosus* – Hairy alectryon – 20 cms
- 114 - *Castanospermum australe* – Black bean – multi 38, 14 cms
- 115 - *Jagera pseudorhus* - Foambark tree – 18 cms
- 116 - *Mallotus philippensis* – Red kamala – multi 21, 17, 7 cms
(Rob says this plant is source of the red dye used in India)
- 117 - *Mallotus philippensis* – Red kamala – 20 cms
- 118 - *Waterhousea floribunda* - Weeping lilly pilly – multi 26, 25, 16 cms
- 119 - *Waterhousea floribunda* - Weeping lilly pilly – multi 4, 7, 17, 20, 19, 31, 24, 10 cms
- 120 - *Parsonia straminea* - Monkey rope vine – 6 cms
- 121 - *Parsonia straminea* - Monkey rope vine – 11 cms
- 122 - *Ficus obliqua* - Small-leaved fig – 140 cms above buttresses, 280 cms at base, growing around dead eucalypt – across other side of Payne Road.
(Rob says 'tree should be nominated for VPO')
- 123 - *Casaurina cunninghamiana* - River oak – 55 cms
- 124 - *Ficus macrophylla* – Moreton Bay fig – multi 26, 19, 38, 50 cms
- 125 - *Toona ciliata* - Red cedar – 40 cms
- 126 - *Lophostemon confertus* – Brush box – 110 cms
- 127 - *Acacia disparrima* – Hickory wattle – multi 29, 29 cms
- 128 - *Eucalyptus tereticornis* - Qld blue gum – 42 cms
- 129 - *Maclura cochinchinensis* – Cockspur thorn vine – multi 13, 11, 9 cms
- 130 - *Waterhousea floribunda* - Weeping lilly pilly – 127 cms
- 131 - *Lophostemon confertus* – Brush box – 140 cms
(Rob estimates the age of this tree as 518 years)
- 132 - *Cryptocarya microneura* – Murrogun – 38 cms
(Rob says a 'significant large tree for this species')

- 6 - *Parsonsia straminea* – Monkey rope vine - 8 cms
- 7 - *Casaurina cunninghamiana* - River oak – 32 cms
- 8 - Indeterminate vine - Milkweed family – likely *Parsonsia straminea* – 5 cms
- 9 - *Casaurina cunninghamiana* - River oak – 40 cms
- 10 - *Mallotus claoxyloides* – Green kamala – 4 cms
- 11 - *Mallotus claoxyloides* – Green kamala - 2 cms
- 12 - *Waterhousea floribunda* - Weeping lilly pilly – multi 24, 72, 29, 30 cms
- 13 - Indeterminate vine - Milkweed family – likely *Parsonsia straminea* – 3 cms
- 14 - *Casaurina cunninghamiana* - River oak – 27 cms
- 15 - *Pleogyne australis* – Pleogyne vine – 14 cms
- 16 - *Alchornea ilicifolia* – Native holly – multi stem but no data
- 17 - *Lophostemon confertus* – Brush box – multi 58, 17 cms
- 18 - *Ficus obliqua* - Small-leaved fig – 4 cms
- 19 - *Guioa semiglauc*a - Wild Quince – 28 cms
- 20 - *Arytera foveolata* – Pitted coogera – multi 15, 7, 18, 6 cms
- 21 - *Planchonella pohlmiana* – Yellow boxwood – 7 cms
- 22 - *Jagera pseudorhus* - Foambark tree – 23 cms
- 23 - *Waterhousea floribunda* - Weeping lilly pilly – multi 47, 23, 23, 46 cms
- 24 - *Austrosteenisia blackii* – Blood vine – 3 cms
- 25 - *Lophostemon confertus* – Brush box – 65 cms
- 26 - *Jagera pseudorhus* - Foambark tree – 39 cms
- 27 - *Denhamia disperma* – Orange boxwood – 23 cms
- 28 - *Tabernaemontana pandacacui* – Banana bush – 2 cms
- 29 - Indeterminate tree – most likely *Corymbia intermedia* – 16 cms
(Buds photographed may have been off *E. siderophloia*)
- 30 - *Cyclophyllum coprosmoides* – Coastal canthium – 3 cms
- 31 - *Notelaea longifolia* – Long-leaved mock-olive – 2 cms
