- 002 – *Backhousia myrtifolia* – Grey myrtle – multi 14, 8, 1, 9, 6 cms
- 003 – *Backhousia myrtifolia* – Grey myrtle – multi 13, 12, 10, 13, 6, 3 cms – damaged by floods
- 004 – *Eucalyptus propinqua* – Small-fruited Grey Gum – 69 cms

- 010 – *Eucalyptus propinqua* – Small-fruited Grey Gum – 76 cms
- 011 – *Eucalyptus propinqua* – Small-fruited Grey Gum – 65 cms
- 012 – *Ficus rubiginosa* – Rock fig (local form) – about 100+ cms
- 013 – *Eucalyptus microcorys* – Tallowwood – multi 44, 65 cms

- 015 – *Rhodomyrtus psidioides* – Native guava – critically endangered due to myrtle rust
- 016 – *Mallotus laoxyloides* – Green Kamala, Smell of the bush – 27 cms – biggest around
- 017 – *Eucalyptus propinqua* – Small-fruited Grey Gum – multi 43, 40, 23 cms
- 018 – *Backhousia leptopetala* (prev. *Choricarpia*) – Brown myrtle – 19 cms – multiple in this location
- 019 – *Eucalyptus siderophloia* – Grey ironbark – multi 53, 40 cms
- 020 – *Olea paniculata* – Native olive – 66 cms
- 021 – *Olea paniculata* – Native olive – 54 cms
- 022 – *Grevillea robusta* – Silky oak – 34 cms
- 023 – *Cupaniopsis parvifolia* – Small-leaved tuckeroo – 51 cms
- 024 – *Lophostemon confertus* – Brush box – 67 cms
- 025 – *Araucaria cunninghamii* – Hoop pine – 55 cms
- 026 – *Rhodamnia rubescens* – Scrub turpentine – multi 7, 8, 6, 5 cms – critically endangered due to myrtle rust
