SENNA PENDULA (CAESALPINIACEAE) EASTER CASSIA

DESCRIPTION

Easter Cassia is a native of South America. Around Easter it produces masses of showy yellow flowers.

WHY IT'S BAD

It "jumps the garden fence" and spreads throughout bushland, outcompeting local species and degrading habitat.

CONTROL

Easy to target at Easter when it's flowering. Stems can be lopped or sawn through low down and painted with neat herbicide.

ALTERNATIVES

Replace with Native Cassia (Edge Senna) an important plant for local butterflies, or dry rainforest shrubs like Lolly Bush, Mutton Brood, Green Kawala and Help Bush.
